




Feedback Analysis for Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS)






Total 63 responses had been recorded using Google Form.




There are around 17 students in the age group of 21 to respond maximum.



Around 52% Male and 48% Female had responded for student satisfaction survey had been recorded.



6. Degree Programme you are studying?






8. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 63 responses



9. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 63 responses





10. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 63 responses





11. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as ⁶³ responses





Internal evaluation process by the teachers are always fair (65.1%)































26. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.


27. The overall quality of teaching - learning process in your institute is very good. 61 responses
